Sean Chen, Pianist (performing November 21, 2024)



The Musical Club is excited to be welcoming **Sean Chen** to its stage. Sean is a Musical Club of Hartford Evelyn Bonar Storrs scholar, a 3rd prize Winner of the 2013 Van Cliburn International Piano Competition, and was named an Annenberg Fellow in 2015. He is a multifaceted

musician who, in addition to performing, also transcribes, composes, and improvises, with many of his transcriptions as well as his compositions having received glowing acclaim. An avid teacher and educator, Mr. Chen is presently the Jack Strandberg/Missouri Endowed Chair Professor of Piano at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory, and is a Steinway Artist.

Anthony Trionfo, Flute, with Albert Cano Smit, Piano (performing April 3, 2025)

Known for his "soaring flute... where dance and song become possible again" (*The Boston Musical Intelligencer*), **Anthony Trionfo** is a "breezily virtuosic" (*The New York Times*) musician actively building one of today's most exciting musical careers. In 2016, Anthony won First Prize



in the <u>Young Concert Artists</u> Susan Wadsworth International Auditions and, in 2018, he made his YCA Series debuts at New York's Merkin Concert Hall and Washington, DC's Kennedy Center along with pianist <u>Albert Cano Smit</u>. Since that time, he has performed throughout the United States. Anthony is a <u>Burkart Flutes & Piccolos</u> artist and plays a 998 Elite silver flute with a 19.5k gold headjoint.
