On Thursday, Oct. 16, 2025, beginning at 10:00 a.m., the Musical Club of Hartford presents a varied program of music featuring accomplished flutists Mark Silk and Janet Stodd, with Michael Yachanin on piano. They will play **Andante and Rondo in A Major, Opus 25**, by Franz Doppler (1821-1883). Franz Doppler was known for being a talented flute virtuoso and composer. He studied with his father, Joseph, and formed a flute duo with his brother, Karl. The Doppler brothers also wrote a number of compositions together.

The Doppler composition will be followed by a selection of familiar tunes from famed Tin Pan Alley composer Hoagy Carmichael (1899-1981), sung by the vocal duo of Patrice Fitzgerald and Richard Leslie, accompanied by T.L. Hine on sax, Walt Gwardyak on piano, Walter Mayo on bass, and David Woodard on drums. Carmichael was one of the most successful songwriters of the thirties and forties, and penned several hundred tunes. He's best known for composing four of the most-recorded American songs of all time: **Stardust, Georgia on My Mind, The Nearness of You**, and **Heart and Soul**—all of which will be performed on the program.
